



Z Bracket Overview

- Krieger Z brackets are used on door assemblies with an applied stop seal system.
- Any hardware that is mounted to the soffit of the frame will need a Z bracket, such as closer arms, strikes, etc.
- The Z bracket mounts over the sound seal assembly (A) as shown in the figure. This provides a rigid mounting surface for closers and other soffit-mounted hardware.
- Krieger provides a heavy-gauge Z bracket (B) and ¼-20" pan head machine screws (C).
- The frame also comes with a reinforcement plate for secure mounting of the brackets.
- The hardware installer is responsible for drilling and tapping to mount the bracket and hardware.




Mounting Instructions for Strikes and Closer Brackets

STEP 1


Make sure to pre-drill the holes for the strike onto the Z bracket before mounting onto the frame.

STEP 2

The Z bracket is mounted in the necessary position and attached with 3 each: ¼-20 PHMS.





The closer bracket is then mounted onto the Z bracket

STEP 3

- The reason for mounting a coordinator to a Z bracket is because the seals will get in the way of the coordinator arms.
- To avoid cutting the seals, the coordinator is again mounted to the Z bracket, and then the whole assembly is mounted onto the frame.



STEP 4

• Then attach another Z bracket with a closer bracket mounted on top of the coordinator Z bracket.



Mounting of an L Bracket with a Closer Bracket

STEP 1

- This is very similar to the Z bracket mounting.
- L brackets are used on frames that are less than 6 %".
- L brackets are mounted onto the face trim of the frame whereas Z brackets are mounted onto the soffit of the frame.
