



What to Know Before Getting Started

- 1. CAUTION: When handling heavy doors, be sure to use cables or straps that are rated to handle the door weights as listed on Krieger's door schedule.**
- 2. NOTE: DO NOT attempt to lift the door from the bottom. Doing so will strain the door in ways it was not designed for and could lead to fitment, installation, and operational issues.**

Installation Instructions

STEP 1

- Install Krieger-supplied heavy duty lifting lugs into the tapped holes.

STEP 2

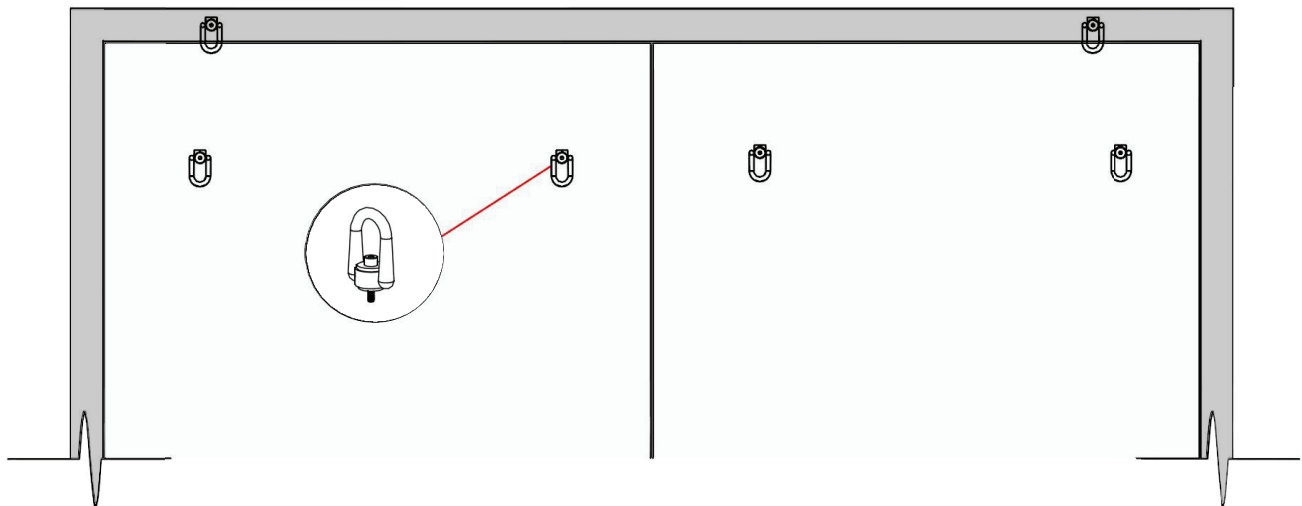
- After the door is hung securely in place, remove the lifting lugs and install the supplied set screw.

STEP 3

- Set the screws flush to the face of the door.

STEP 4

- Hide set screw holes by applying bondo. Let dry, then sand smooth and paint as desired.
